DEVILKNOWSMYNAME bobbled leaving the gate, steadied in tight between horses nearing the far turn, steadied inside nearing the stretch, swung out between horses leaving the turn and bumped VITO TONY N BILLY, rallied to the front nearing the final sixteenth then ran clear late. RED LIGHT DISTRICT advanced inside around the final turn, steadied in tight nearing the stretch, split horses to vie inside the winner after seven furlongs but couldn't keep up late. PICADILLY PETE was never far back, moved three wide to command leaving the final turn, ran clear before seven furlongs then gave way soon after. ROAD TO HOPE was slow to settle, swung wide into the stretch and was gaining outside when the rider stood up before the finish. METRO settled early, raced the three path around the final turn, fell back in early stretch then made a belated run. VITO TONY N BILLY raced two wide between horses around the final turn, was bumped by the winner while fanning out entering the stretch then flattened out. CASTLE ROCKSTAR was outrun. S S SKITTLES pressed two wide outside the early leader to the stretch then tired. NIN'S THERMOMETER made the pace along the rail to the stretch then stopped.
