LUTHERAN MISS stalked the pace between horses and took over the lead at the three eighths pole and drew off from there. ENDLESS RIDE went four wide around both turns while tracking the pace on the outside, responded well when roused and finished with a good effort. MILWAUKEE RED tracked the pace setters, angled to the rail at the three sixteenths pole and had a game finish. WANDO'S REBEL entered the first turn five wide but took most of it about three or four wide, sat off the pace then lacked the needed rally. SOUERTIME was never a threat. ART SERIES showed little. BAZINGA B set the early pace and held it most of the way but folded up at the quarter pole.
