SIERRA SUN was away in good order to duel for the lead with GOLD MAN while racing from off the rail, vied with that rival through a prolonged drive and gamely prevailed. GOLD MAN was off slow, rushed to vie, disputed the pace with the winner while racing three-wide throughout and gave way grudgingly to that rival in a game effort. DEMOGRAPHIC TREND was reserved just off the leaders early, moved five-wide through the second turn and was up for the show. STUDENT UNION settled off the leaders early, moved four-wide through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. MODEST MOUSE showed no early speed, saved ground through the second turn, reached a contending position into the stretch and finished evenly late. CASTLE ROCKSTAR lacked early foot, raced four-wide through the second turn and was not a factor. BACK SCATTER raced off the pacesetters from the inside and gradually weakened.
