FORTY NINE WATTS settled wide off the pace, bid on the final turn, came in under a right handed whip after taking the lead at the top of the stretch crowding inside rivals and edged clear. NICE SURPRISE lagged far behind, advanced very wide and closed well too late. I WILL moved three wide on the final turn, was taken up at the top of the stretch but continued gamely STUDENT UNION chased between rivals for three quarters and retreated. GRAY NOT BAY hustled outside to duel to the stretch then weakened. PIN NUMBER saved ground off the pace and never menaced. STAR OF SARAVA vied for the advantage inside then was taken up tiring at the top of the stretch. Following a stewards inquiry and an objection by the rider of I WILL against the first finisher for interference at the top of the stretch, FORTY NINE WATTS was disqualified and placed last.
