DISCREET DUKE stalked the pace on the outside and vied for the lead at the three eighths pole, set down for the drive but was outfinished. STUDENT UNION was fractious in the gate but broke well and was well rated early on, went five wide turning for home and finished evenly. MARCHOSO was reluctant to load but broke on to and quickly went to the front, held the lead for a while but faded. MEDALLICIOUS lacked the needed rally. BORN A HERO was no factor. OHNONOTAGAIN chased the pace early on but had no response.
