SYDNEY TIME went five wide around the first turn while stalking the pace on the outside, then entered the stretch in the six path closing with a rush a drew off. BOWTIE DIVA stalked the pace along the inside then ran gamely along the rail but was rundown by the closer. PLATINUM AFFAIR had a comfortable lead the whole way then responded very well when collared digging in when asked for more but was outfinished. STINA chased the pace along the inside then angled to the outside going into the turn for home then finished up evenly. CALCULATION went four wide around the first turn between horses, began to rally in the stretch but her hole closed in at the eighth pole and angled out then rallied well from there. RIVERWALK WEEKEND was very quick into stride then had settled down chasing the pace while going three wide around the first turn, stayed towards the front but came up empty at the quarter pole. BRAZILIAN SYMPHONY was no factor. LITERARY LADY was never a threat.
