Footnotes

C. D. JAMMIN gave chase about the three path, rounded the turn four wide, dueled to the front midstretch, raced clear past the sixteenth pole and held on. MERRY'S VERY WON steadied lightly on the chute, picked up the chase into the backstretch, rounded the turn about the five path, angled to the outside entering the stretch and dug in to take place the final strides. ARKAYBEE chased the pace toward the inside, raced nearest the rail rounding the turn, eased three wide past the eighth pole and finished evenly while ceding second the final strides. DEVIL RISING gave chase about the four path, rounded the turn five wide, lost ground entering the stretch, though finished evenly. LOVE IN THE RAIN moved to even terms nearest the rail approaching the three eighths pole, had a slim lead toward the five sixteenths pole, raced clear into the lane then weakened the final sixteenth. KOHL dropped back outside from the early going, moved toward the inside at the five sixteenths pole and raced evenly through the lane. COPY CATTER hustled clear past the chute while angling in, was met at even terms while two deep past the three eighths pole, gave chase from that point but dropped back nearing the end of the turn and weakened in the stretch.
