STUDENT UNION stalked the pace on the inside then took the four path into the stretch, hit his best stride in the final furlong and was able to hold off the closer. THE SUNDROP KID went four wide around the turns while tracking the pace then closed willingly in the stretch to just miss. REBEL SPY went three wide around the turn but was allowed to relax off the pace, had a late run in the stretch but it was not enough. REGGIE D went four or five wide around the turns while running off the pace, rallied well in the stretch but it was not enough. ZURI MWANA went four wide around the first turn but got up to duel for the lead on the outside then faded late. BRITESUNNYSKY was quick into stride out of the gate then dueled for the lead along the inside then faded in the stretch. MARCH STAR settled towards the rear while taking the first turn in the four path then was able to gain late. NICE SURPRISE went three wide around the turns while stalking the pace on the outside but had no rally in the stretch. BIG BAD IKE went four wide around the first turn and was allowed to settle early on but failed to respond in the stretch. MANX stalked the pace between horses but stopped at the quarter pole and was eased down the lane. STRONG APPEAL was allowed to settle early on but faded at the half mile pole then was eased in the stretch. STRONGEST was taken up hitting traffic at the three quarters pole but settled into stride soon after, was no factor from there and was eased down the stretch.
