DIRTY DOZEN raced two wide between rivals into the stretch, edged out while rallying into the final furlong, reached the front in late stretch and was clear at the end. MARCH TO GLORY settled, raced three wide around the final turn and finished fast outside. OCTAVIA HILL was urged along while making the pace in the two path then gave way late. YOUR TURN stalked outside the early leader in the three path and weakened in the drive. LUMINOUS CIELO wasn't far back while four wide around the final turn but couldn't gain in the lane. SHAMROCK GAL was close up between rivals early, lacked racing room while behind the leader around the final turn then faded. AMAZING GRACE RVF advanced outside on the backstretch, gave her best three wide between rivals on the final turn, flattened out then was vanned off lame following the race. NUB stopped inside.
