TALENTEDLOVEAFFAIR, racing in the three path while just off the pace, split rivals on the final turn, drifted out rallying through stretch and won under strong handling. DIRTY DOZEN gradually eased off the rail and split rivals on the far turn, swung very wide into stretch, drifted wider under left handed pressure and gained place. FOREST DEW, outside and just off the pace, took the lead near stretch, also drifted out and gave way. H K'S MERIDA set the pace in the three path and faded through the final furlong. DIADEMA stalked the pace from the four path and then tired. LADY A. G., three wide, failed to threaten. LITTLE MISS EMILY saved ground and dropped back steadily. PENNY LOVER showed little.
