DIADEMA was rated outside in the three path, was urged to vie approaching the lane, took over in early stretch and held after a long drive. H K'S MERIDA made the early pace close to the inside and gave way grudgingly. FOREST DEW wasn't far back along the inside, came out on the final turn and lacked a closing response. DIRTY DOZEN wasn't far back outside to the far turn, ran out entering the stretch and stopped. HONEYDUKES wasn't far back between rivals to the far turn then stopped. KELMACK stayed inside, the saddle slipped forward causing the rider to lose her irons.
