AL'S JUBALEE dueled for the lead on the inside, kept the momentum going into the stretch running gamely down the lane and prevailed. CANDY SHACK dueled for the lead on the outside, kept up the pace into the stretch and finished gamely. SHEER TALENT chased the pace between horses up the backstretch but got a spot on the rail for the turn then ran all out through the finish. JUMPIN FRAC FLASH chased the pace on the outside going three wide around the turn, responded well when asked for more and ran gamely through the finish. SMOOTH SERVICE chased the pace between horses, bumped with BEAR'S COWBOY a but near the half mile pole but was unfazed then finished with a good effort. GEORGE JET stalked the pace on the inside then had to swung out into the four path at the top of the stretch then finished evenly. BEAR'S COWBOY bumped with SMOOTH SERVICE at the half but was unfazed, swung for home in the five path but was no factor.
