KOHL broke sharply, opened a clear lead midway on the backstretch, stayed inside and held stubbornly. HAY SEEKER made a strong run outside horses after a quarter, vied outside the winner into the stretch but wasn't enough. SMOOTH SERVICE was bumped midway on the backstretch, was caught in tight entering the turn then faded in the lane. REGGIE D broke slowly, lagged early then passed tired ones. CHASING STARS advanced wide on the turn then flattened out. MR. TALENT chased the winner early, raced out from the inside around the turn then stopped. KAROBUSHKA made a run along the rail on the turn then tired. CONDO CLOSING was outrun. JOEY WHISPERS drifted out into MID LIFE CRISIS midway on the backstretch, stopped and was eased up through the stretch. MID LIFE CRISIS was bumped into SMOOTH SERVICE midway on the backstretch, stopped and was eased up through the lane.
