Non-winners Of A Race At A Mile Or Over Since June 7 Allowed 2 lbs. Such A Race Since May 7 Allowed 4 lbs. (Races Where Entered For \$16,000 Or Less Not Considered In Eligibility And Allowances) (Preference To Horses That Have Not Started For Less Than \$12,500 In Last 4 Starts). (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course it will be run on the main track at One Mile. If more than 10 horses remain it will be run at One Mile and Seventy Yards.). ### Footnotes

MOVE was well in hand while not far back along the rail, advanced around the final turn, took over entering the stretch then drew off under intermittent urging. ISLAND ROMANCE made the early pace two wide between rivals and was no match for the winner while clearly second best. LITTLE MISS EMILY bumped with PRINCESS PENELOPE leaving the gate, moved to press outside the early leader in the three path then tired in the lane. DIRTY DOZEN angled outside while unhurried on the backstretch, raced four wide around the final turn and tired. PRINCESS PENELOPE was fractious in the gate, bumped with LITTLE MISS EMILY leaving the gate, fell far back after a half and was eased up through the lane.
