GENERAL SHAM'MAH rallied three wide between horses around the turn, took over after five furlongs then drew out late. SMOOTH SERVICE rallied four wide around the turn, took over after a half then gave way. TWO IS TO MANY forced or set the pace two wide for a half then weakened. BULLY SONG wasn't far back inside early, came out on the turn then weakened. KOVARRO dueled early, angled to the rail on the turn, the rider dropped her whip in early stretch then faded. PARSEGHIAN fell back early, came out wide on the turn and failed to menace.
