GREY GATOR settled outside, was sent to vie outside the early leader in the three path on the final turn then drew out under steady urging. RARE ART wasn't far back three wide early, stayed close to the inside around the final turn, angled outside in early stretch then passed tired ones in an even effort and was up for the place. KOOL KAT STRUT was unhurried, made a three wide run around the final turn to get closer in early stretch then flattened out. RESURRECTION BAY stayed out from the rail while making the pace for over three quarters then tired. WORLD CHANGER was slow early, raced the three path and lacked a rally. PERSIE chased outside the early leader in the three path and was finished after three quarters. JOEY CAP was outrun. PROSPECTOR ALLEY was caught wide around the first turn, remained in good position on the outside to the far turn then stopped.
