INDUSTRY LEADER bumped with KOVARRO leaving the gate, moved clear soon after, was rated close to the inside and was best under mild urging. POLISHED DEGREE was hustled to chase the winner outside but couldn't gain. TWO IS TO MANY wasn't far back inside early, fell back on the turn then continued evenly. KOOL KAT STRUT was close up between horses early, fell back two wide on the turn, angled out sharply in early stretch then regained ground outside. RICHIE'S RICH raced three wide between horses around the turn and lacked a strong closing. KOVARRO bumped with the winner leaving the gate, stayed inside and failed to menace. THE SILVER SNIPER wasn't far back outside early, raced four wide around the turn, steadied in early stretch and stopped. RUNNING CAT trailed and was eased up through the lane.
