EXTREMIST settled, raced three wide around the turn, swung outside for room entering the final furlong and was up in time. ROSIE'S FAITH was never far back, rallied two wide between rivals around the turn, opened a short lead entering the final furlong and gave way in the final yards. BLUE HEN MADNESS showed speed outside the from the start, raced four wide around the turn, remained prominent through the lane but lacked the needed closing response. I SCREAM SUNDAY was prominent from the outset while racing out from the inside, ran out while in control into the stretch and continued with good courage once displaced. HOPEFUL TIMES raced two wide inside the winner into the stretch, edged out in early stretch then continued evenly. SIDISINFORTHREE broke slowly then was outrun in the three path. SOXY RUBY broke slowly, steadied sharply early on the backstretch and failed to menace. SILK N' SEQUINS was outrun. TRUE COST showed speed inside for about a half then stopped.
