BARBIE LOCA went three wide around the first turn while tracking the pace, got inside and hugged the rail turning for home and ran very gamely through the finish. HANNAH'S GAMBLE went four wide around the first turn while staking the pace on the outside, got in tight at the quarter pole then faded. VALERIE VICTORIA was hustled out of the gate to quickly take the lead, held it into the stretch but surrendered with a furlong to go. DYNA SUE sat well rated off the pace while taking the first turn in the four path then had a mild repsonse when asked for more. MARCH TO GLORY was no factor. BELLE OF BOWDOIN showed little. LITTLE MISS EMILY failed to menace.
