HOPEFUL TIMES stumbled at the start but quickly recovered to stalk the pace on the outside, turned for home going three wide when she dug in, rallied, and prevailed. FORMAL CLASS stumbled at the start but quickly got into stride to get up and duel for the lead on the outside, went three wide turning for home and began to kick clear running gamely through the drive but got sniped by the winner. DESERT JEWEL trailed early on, turned for home going six wide with a strong rally and almost got up in time. DARING PROSPECT chased the pace between horses but lost ground at the three eighths pole but uncorked a mild gain in the stretch. VANIDOSA chased the pace on the inside and finished evenly. CAMPEONA dueled for the lead between horses then retreated. HONEST FEELINGS was reluctant to load then bobbed at the start then got up to duel for the lead on the inside but gave way. FIRELIGHT tracked the pace while going five wide then lacked the needed rally. ROSIE'S FAITH tracked the pace while going four wide, got brushed and in tight a few times in the stretch but lacked the needed rally.
