MR BRIONI tracked the pace on the outside going three wide around the turn, swung into the stretch in the five path and uncorked an outside rally, edged clear within the final sixteenth. ICE KAUFY vied for the lead going around the turn in the three and four paths, ran gamely between horses through the finish. BARRACUDA WAYNE was allowed to settle off the pace while running in the three path then had a late rally. WHATSTHEQUESTION sat well rated off the pace while in the three path then rallied well when asked for more. THE COOKIE MAN inched clear on the backstretch and on the turn to hold a comfortable lead but was swallowed up in the final furlong. EARLY ONE MORNING chased the pace on the inside then weakened. CUMBERLAND GAP chased the pace between horses going two wide around the turn but was no match for the top finishers. BECAUSE HE CAN ran in the three path but failed to menace.
