HIDE A ROSE took over from the outside before going a furlong, stayed out from the rail around the turn and held after a prolonged drive. MILE END broke slowly, advanced outside early, vied outside the winner in the three path on the turn but wasn't enough. ROSIE'S FAITH was slow early, advanced three wide between rivals around the turn but lacked a closing response. EVENING PRIZE bobbled and fell back leaving the gate, made a four wide run around the turn and continued evenly through the lane. PLATINUM AFFAIR stayed out from the rail around the turn while slow early then made a late run between. STORMY'S HONOR showed speed between rivals, was caught in tight entering the turn then faded. ALICE'S GIRLS showed speed inside to the turn then stopped.
