BECAUSE HE CAN settled outside, moved wide on the turn, angled back near the inside in the lane and rallied clear. LONG MAY YOU RUN prompted the pace outside, edged to the front midway on the turn and continued gamely. MALIBU HIGH rushed up inside down the backstretch, was very wide into the stretch and offered a mild bid. SECRETIVE hustled to the front off the inside, vied to mid-stretch and weakened. STRONGBAKSTEELTOES broke sluggishly, advanced inside then flattened out. IT DOESNT END WELL dropped back early and never menaced. SYNCHRONOUS chased very wide and lacked a rally. SURFING U S A lagged far behind then passed fading rivals. POMEROY'S PACKAGE prompted the pace four wide and gave way through the stretch. DAN'S GOLD chased in mid-pack early and weakened steadily. ICE COLD CASH chased wide and gave way readily.
