FIRE ALARM settled inside, came out on the final turn while under urging, swung three wide into the stretch and drew out under urging before a mile. GREY GATOR was carried wide on the first turn while unhurried, began a run from the outside after a half, moved three wide to a clear lead nearing the stretch then weakened. WORLD CHANGER was slow to settle, raced two wide around the final turn then made a belated run between tired ones. YOU'RE NO SAINT was carried wide around the first turn then was outrun. E TAKES THE LEAD came out on the backstretch while chasing the early leader, moved two wide to a short lead midway on the final turn then tired. PROSPECTOR ALLEY ran clear into the first turn, angled to the inside, remained in command into the far turn then tired. BOILERMAKER ran out around the first turn, advanced between horses on the backstretch, ran out entering the stretch and stopped. GRIS HOMBRE stopped.
