OBSESS dueled for the lead on the outside while running four wide, dug in and shook clear with a sixteenth to go. CUMBERLAND GAP hit the gate at the start then got up to chase the pace while running in the three path then uncorked a rally when asked. PHIL'S COCKTAIL dueled for the lead between horses while going three wide around the turn, ran gamely through the stretch but grew tired within the last sixteenth. NIIGON EXPRESS chased the pace then had a late run in the stretch. BUFFALO (BRZ) dueled for the lead between horses then began to fade at the quarter pole. NEBIKON passed tiring rivals. GREY GATOR ran towards the rear, angled out at the eighth pole looking for running room but was no factor. DEMAND bobbed at the start but quickly recovered and dueled for the lead on the inside until he stopped at the three eights pole. CHO TIME broke in the air then rider lost irons, was eased the whole way and walked off.
