GREY GATOR was unhurried, steadied two wide into the far turn, came out then finished fast outside. PAPAL LAW ran out while showing speed into the first turn, moved to vie two wide into the far turn, dueled to midstretch then weakened. SMART AND TOUGH moved through horses to gain command before going a furlong, angled to the inside, made the pace for over three quarters then weakened. DOWNHILL RACER made a run from the outside into the far turn then lacked a strong closing. HELLO ABRAXON was carried out while showing speed three wide into the first turn, remained prominent three wide around the final turn then tired. FORT RILEY was outrun. WILDCAT CARTRIDGE stopped inside.
