Footnotes

CORT'N ASONG wasn't never far back along the rail, waited for room approaching the stretch, got clear in early stretch, took over leaving the furlong grounds and widened under urging. SPIN MOVE opened a short lead soon after the break, stayed close to the rail while making the way into the final furlong then gave way. SPEIGHTSHILL lagged early then was going fastest through late stretch. JUDGE CARR had early position between rivals, raced three wide around the turn, was caught in tight and bumped with WILLIWAW entering the stretch then continued evenly. ULTRAFLAME began a run outside on the backstretch, gave his best four wide nearing the stretch, was bumped lightly entering the stretch and weakened. WILLIWAW pressed outside the early leader, was caught in tight and bumped with JUDGE CARR entering the stretch then tired. HIGHROLLER DAVE was slow from the gate, came out sharply entering the turn and failed to menace. RESURRECTION BAY briefly showed speed between horses.
