WHATDAELLBECA bobbled then bumped with ALWAYS SATISFIED leaving the gate, moved to chase the early leader, vied two wide on the outside on the turn, ran clear in early stretch and was kept to task. ALWAYS SATISFIED bobbled leaving the gate then bumped with the winner then bumped CONTRADANCE after the break, had position in the three path around the turn then gained mildly to the end. An objection by Hernandez against the winner was not allowed. ISLAND LADY was shuffled back after the break, angled to the inside, rallied the turn, came out between rivals in the lane and finished willingly. ALBEIT SYLVIA advanced inside early and lacked a closing response. CONTRADANCE came out leaving the gate, bumped with ALWAYS SATISFIED then steadied soon after, saved ground around the turn, came out between rivals for the drive and gained too late, An objection by Micklos against the winner was not allowed. PROMOTORA lagged early, raced wide around the turn and made up ground outside late. CHEETAH'S TAIL wasn't far back between rivals early, raced the three path around the turn and lacked a closing response. CLIFF DIVING DOUG was outrun two wide. ROSIE BELLE moved to a clear lead early on the backstretch, held on along the rail to the stretch then stopped. TRUST N KEELY was finished early.
