PEACH ALLEY set a pressured pace on the outside, went two wide around the turn, drew off and won driving. FANCY IS MY NAME got hit by the gate door when it bounced back after opening but appeared unfazed, went in and bumped with MISS MANATEE as the pair came into stride but quickly shook it off and went up and vied for the lead on the inside then ran gamely through the finish. CAT GIUMARELLO chased the pace going three wide, ran gamely through the stretch but it was not enough. ROLLING MO tracked the pace on the inside then came up empty at the five sixteenths pole. HYGH LIFE tracked the pace on the outside going four wide around the turn, showed brief speed at the quarter pole but flattened out. MISS MANATEE got brushed by the gate when the door opened but bounced back slightly, bumped with FANCY IS MY NAME as the pair came into stride then settled to track the pace, went two wide around the turn but had no rally. SOBEIT SYLVIA tracked the pace between horses going three wide around the turn, showed brief speed at the quarter pole then flattened out. LADY A. G. inside, trailed.
