NOONAN ON THURSDAY settled inside, came out four wide on the final turn while rallying, moved to vie outside the leader entering the final furlong and was narrowly best after a stiff drive. GRIT'N'GRIND threw his head just before the doors opened, left the gate very slowly, was sent to press two wide outside the early leader, took over two wide on the final turn and continued with good courage. INOROUT was never far back, was sent to vie three wide on the final turn and tired in the lane. HE STARTED IT made the pace along the rail for about three quarters and tired in the lane. A SMILE FOR ELLIE couldn't keep up.
