RAGING MARKET ducked out leaving the gate, gained position three wide then tired. SPEED GAME was caught four wide around the first turn, raced three wide around the final turn and tired. BIG BAD DUDE chased in the two path for over three quarters then stopped. BESTAVAILABLE was outrun. GAME BREAKER raced wide around the final turn while outrun. HE STARTED IT stopped.
