RING COLLECTOR steadied while rated outside nearing the turn, moved the three path to command midway on the turn then drew away under mild urging.

RUN FOR ZACH was urged closer two wide between horses before a half then flattened out. MAJESTIC WOODY was hustled inside early, came out in

early stretch and continued evenly. POINT OF VISION lagged into the final furlong the passed tired ones. HE STARTED IT broke slowly, raced three wide

and tired. DUKE OF FLATBUSH made the early pace in the two path then stopped in the lane.
