CIRCUS MUSIC was quick into stride and bounded forward to take the lead, stayed on the inside and drifted out a bit into the two path at the top of the stretch but a win was never in doubt, ridden out. LADY A. G. tracked the pace while going two wide around the turns, ran all out in the stretch but it was not enough. HIGH SIERRA had her hole close in as they passed the thirteen sixteenths pole but stayed at the back of the pack while on the rail, was forced to swing into the stretch in the six path with a long rally in tow but it was no match. OH MY PRECIOUS chased the pace on the outside while going three and four wide around the turns but faded at the three eighths pole. COURAGEOUS LYNNE got shuffled back at the start but settled to track the pace on the outside, went around the turns in the three and four paths but had no rally when asked for more. MARLEE'S MAGIC vied for the lead between horses while going two wide around the turns, weakened for the drive. HEARTY JONES chased the pace between horses while going two and three wide around the turns but had a steady fade after half a mile.
