TRULAMO was allowed to settle early, advanced five-wide through the second turn, reached the fore with a furlong to run and drew clear. SYDNEY TIME lagged early, raced four-wide through the second turn, angled out further into the lane and finished with good late energy. QUEENA ESTHER was reserved just off the leaders early, raced three-wide through the second turn, angled out further nearing the three-sixteenths marker and finished willingly. CIRCUS MUSIC was forwardly placed early, raced four-wide through the second turn, offered a bid into the lane and failed to sustain her rally. PLEASURE TRIP settled off the leaders early, raced three-wide through the second turn, angled out further in mid-stretch and lacked the needed rally. LYDIA SWEETIE broke sharply to press the pace of HAY YOU GUYS while racing three-wide, moved up to engage that foe after going three furlongs, vied for three-quarters and weakened. HAY YOU GUYS was away in good order to set a pressured pace from the inside, responded when challenged by LYDIA SWEETIE nearing the five furlong marker, vied with that rival and weakened after going six furlongs.
