Footnotes

PERSIE stalked the pace of PERFECT EXECUTION while racing four-wide, moved up to take command with a furlong to run and was fully extended to hold BELLOWS safe late. BELLOWS was reserved just off the leaders early, advanced four-wide through the second turn and finished with a steady bid. AIN'T MISBEHAVIN was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out in mid-stretch and finished with good late energy. BUILT THAT WAY lacked early speed, raced off the rail through the second turn, angled out in mid-stretch and finished willingly. PERFECT EXECUTION sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace and gave way through the final furlong. BOBBY THE BRAIN settled off the leaders early, moved four-wide through the second turn and failed to rally. SMART TWO A T raced four-wide through both turns, raced off the pacesetters and gradually weakened. FINE lacked early foot, raced six-wide through the second turn and was not a factor. COUNT ON AMERICA showed brief speed and weakened.
