Footnotes

MASTER YANK was reserved just off the leaders early, advanced four-wide through the second turn, responded when set down for the drive and was up in the closing yards. PERSIE stalked the pace of PERFECT EXECUTION while racing three-wide, moved up to take command nearing the three-sixteenths pole, opened a clear lead but could not resist the winner late. BUSTIN THE BANK lagged early, raced three-wide through the second turn and finished fastest of all. PERFECT EXECUTION sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace and gave way through the final furlong. SPEAKER JOHN broke sharply to chase the leaders from the inside and weakened after going five furlongs.
