Footnotes

BOBBY G steadied and bumped with DAZZLING OAKIE when placed in tight quarters by SEBRAY entering the first turn, was patiently rated down the backstretch, eased out three wide approaching the stretch, circled horses, was floated to the four path in upper stretch, gained the lead outside foes near the eighth pole and drew out under left hand urging. DAZZLING OKIE bumped with the winner entering the first turn, saved ground around the turns, found room near the inner rail through the stretch and rallied mildly. PERSIE, sent to the early lead, set the pace off the rail, drifted to the three path turning for home and weakened. FEDERAL WALK chased the pace outside PERSIE and weakened in the drive. SEBRAY tightened quarters on horses when drifting in approaching the first turn, saved ground the far turn, swung wide in upper stretch and tired late. A TRUE GENTLEMAN, squeezed back by SEBRAY approaching the first turn, was outrun. SUPER VISION, four deep the far turn, stopped and was eased.
