Footnotes

DOUBLE WHAMMY settled well off the pace for a half-mile, began moving approaching the far turn, rallied past rivals four then five wide going to the quarter-pole, caught PRIVATE PARTY from the outside in upper stretch, and widened while kept driving. PRIVATE PARTY sped clear early through a sharp pace, built a lengthy advantage well off the rail through the middle stages, could not resist the top one by upper stretch, but kept on well enough to salvage second. SIR ALFRED raced mostly three wide, and lacked a solid bid. THESE BLUES went along in midpack three wide for six furlongs, moved inside making up some ground through upper stretch, and flattened out. WATCH MY DUST was devoid of speed saving ground early, moved out three wide on the far turn, and passed tired horses. PERSIE chased after the pacesetter while put to the whip throughout the backstretch run, and gave way before completing six furlongs. CODE NAME RAVEN was finished early. GENERAL PADDY saved ground and was done after a half-mile.
