STADIUM settled while not far back, was sent to vie four wide into the far turn, drew out midway on that turn and widened under urging. THE GREAT CASBY made a run three wide into the far turn then flattened out in the lane. BARON BARRACUDA wasn't far back inside, made a run three wide inside the winner into the far turn then tired. WONDERFULLY TUNED was slow early then passed tired ones. RAVENS DELIGHT was caught wide while unhurried around the first turn, made a four wide run into the far turn then stopped. ATHELSTANE made the pace along the rail for about three quarters then stopped. PERSIE was roused from the gate, dueled two wide, was roused on the backstretch, stopped after five furlongs and was eased up through the stretch.
