W. GILES was quick into stride and skipped clear to an easy lead, cruised on the front in the two path, edged clear early in the stretch but began to fade, dug in and held on, won driving. CIRCLE UNBROKEN lugged out at the start then settled to track the pace on the outside, entered the turn in the four path but cut the corner and got on the rail just past the seven sixteenths pole, stayed on the inside through the turn then rallied well in the stretch almost getting up in time. SIR BOND lugged out a bit at the break and bumped into PHONE MY POSSE in the process, sat well rated off the pace while going two wide around the turn, swung into the stretch in the four path then hit his best stride with a sixteenth to go. IT'S NOT FUNNY chased the pace on the outside while going three wide around the turn, lacked the needed rally. POINT OF VISION was reluctant to load then bobbed at the break, was allowed to settle off the pace and went around the turn in the three and four paths but needed more when asked in the stretch. JUST BY CHANCE bobbed at the start then went up and chased the pace while going two wide around the turn, came up empty at the eighth pole. PHONE MY POSSE lugged in a bit at the start and bumped into SIR BOND in the process, tracked the pace on the inside but grew tired with three eighths to go. LOOKINGFORANEWHOME was allowed to settle off the pace while running in the three path, faded for the drive. MR. TALENT sat well rated off the pace while on the inside, came up empty at the three eighths pole and was eased down the lane.
