DOUBLE SKY broke sharply to talk the pace of W. GILES while racing four-wide, responded when set down for the drive and wore that rival down in the final yards. W. GILES sprinted clear at once, raced three-wide while setting the pace, remained in control through mid-stretch but could not resist the winner late. WHATSTHEQUESTION was bumped at the start, settled off the leaders early, raced five-wide through the turn and finished with a steady bid. BIG LEGACY was bumped at the break then forwardly placed from the inside, remained inside for the drive and failed to gain late. LEONARDO DA VINCI showed no early speed, raced three-wide through the turn and was not a factor. SPEIGHTSHILL was bumped at the start then forwardly placed, raced four-wide through the turn and gave way in the drive. BRAVE REQUEST was bumped at the break, showed no early speed, saved ground through the turn and was not a factor.
