CIRCLE UNBROKEN was away in good order to stalk the pace of W. GILES while racing four-wide, moved up to take command nearing the three-sixteenths pole, quickly drew off and won with something left. WHATSTHEQUESTION lacked early speed, raced four-wide through the turn, angled out in mid-stretch and finished with good energy. SPEIGHTSTOWN TIME settled off the leaders early, raced three-wide through the turn and finished with a steady bid. SPEIGHTSHILL was forwardly placed early, raced five-wide through the turn and finished evenly in the drive. BUTCH CASSIDY hesitated at the start, lagged early, raced seven-wide through the turn and passed tiring foes late. W. GILES sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace and gave way through the final furlong. BIG LEGACY settled off the leaders early, raced three-wide through the turn and failed to rally. AL DO GREAT was void of early speed, raced four-wide through the turn and was not a factor. DAVID ROCKS was fractious at the gate, chased the leaders from the inside for the opening quarter and weakened.
