LIMERICK LIGHTNING raced off the pace toward the outside, bid nearing the three eighths pole, took aim four wide at the quarter pole, dug in from the top of the stretch, got up at the seventy yard pole and raced clear under the wire. MONEYBAGS settled off the pace outside, bid leaving the five eighths pole, steadily progressed five wide on the turn and finished well to take second the final strides. W. GILES took the lead leaving the chute and rated the pace, was pressured from the half mile pole, dug in with the advantage through most of the stretch, was headed at the seventy yard pole then nipped from second the final strides. ROB N THE BANK saved ground off the pace, bid leaving the nine sixteenths pole then flattened stride inside the eighth pole. MOUNTAIN CRY raced off the early pace in the three and four paths, angled out leaving the turn, entered the stretch widest and finished evenly. LEONARDO DA VINCI raced off the pace inside, showed little response through the backstretch and raced at the rail rounding the turn. SILBIDO stalked the pace through the backstretch and continued close to the mid point of the turn before beginning to fade.
