IT'S A TREND broke sharply to stalk the pace of LITTLE STORMIN while racing three-wide, moved up to take command nearing the five-sixteenths pole, quickly opened a clear lead and was fully extended to hold off the closing FLEUR DE FORCE late. FLEUR DE FORCE was reserved just off the leaders early, raced four-wide through the second turn, responded when set down for the drive and was gaining on the winner late. GIA ALEXA raced unhurried early, saved ground through the second turn, angled out approaching the stretch and finished willingly. E LIZZY settled of the leaders early, raced five-wide through the second turn and finished with a steady bid. FOXY GATOR lacked early foot, raced four-wide through the second turn and failed to rally. KELLYSLITTLESECRET was void of early speed, raced four-wide through the second turn and was not a factor. DIVINE KITTEN showed no early speed, raced five-wide through the second turn and did not offer a bid. TURKS AND CHAOS was forwardly placed early, raced three-wide through the second turn and gradually weakened. ICE PALACE raced four-wide through both turns, settled off the leaders and weakened. LITTLE STORMIN sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace and weakened after going three-quarters.
