Footnotes

PAPACHO saved ground and well off of a hotly contested pace, came off the rail to begin a run mid turn, swung out to be about five wide in upper stretch, leveled off under strong hand encouragement, forged to command nearing the sixteenth pole, eagerly went clear and held firm. SARATOGA WILDCAT , between foes early, dropped back under a ride leaving the far turn, picked up some steam off the rail in upper stretch, swung out in mid stretch and finished with good energy to get up for the place. KEY MONO vied outside STONE BANDIT through swift fractions, stayed with that one to mid stretch then gave way grudgingly. STONE BANDIT dueled inside, edged away slightly leaving the three sixteenths then faded late. SCOUT'S HONOR , four wide between rivals early, angled in to gain around the turn, edged up behind rivals in upper stretch, angled out but failed to seriously sustain. MARTYWITHTHEPARTY broke a step slow, raced five deep early on, emerged from the pack to make a four wide run mid turn, loomed into the stretch then flattened out. FAR FROM AWESOME was outrun.
