### Footnotes

TURKS AND CHAOS lugged in at the start and bumped into MAGGIE LAINE in the process, shook it off and went out into the six path while stalking the pace, moved up and vied for the lead at the half mile pole, turned for home in the four path and began to edge clear, went to the whip only once the whole race near the eighth pole but continued on and won handily. GIA ALEXA sat well rated off the pace while cruising in the five path, rallied well in the stretch, suddenly lost action and appeared to angle out as they neared the finish line. ROMAN REIGN set a pressured pace while running in the two and three paths, grew tired as they passed the quarter pole. FLEUR DE FORCE chased the pace between horses while running in the five path, ran all out through the finish. DYNA SUE got bumped at the start when MAGGIE LAINE was pushed into her, shook it off and went up to chase the pace while in the four path, maintained her position then swung into the stretch in the seven path but had no response when asked for more and was eased. MAGGIE LAINE got jostled around at the start when TURKS AND CHAOS pushed her into DYNA SUE leaving the gate, quickly got into stride and went up and vied for the lead between horses, went around the turns in the five path but was spent by the half mile pole then eased down the lane.
