SARATOGA WILDCAT was away alertly then was reserved just off leaders, moved three-wide through the turn, angled out further into the lane, reached the fore with a furlong to run and drew clear through the closing yards. GRATEFUL CAUSE was bumped at the break, pressed the pace of UGOTTAAHAVEHEART while racing three-wide, moved up to take a slight advantage nearing the five-sixteenths pole and gave way to the winner through the final furlong. HARD HITTER was off a step slow and bumped, moved up quickly to race just off the lead, advanced five-wide through the turn, reached a striking position but failed to gain late. MORE THAN SHIRL hopped at the start, lagged early, raced off the rail through the turn and finished with some late run. UGOTTAAHAVEHEART set a pressured pace from off the rail, weakened after going a half and was eased through the stretch. PARADE OF NATIONS lacked early foot, raced four-wide through the turn and was not a factor.
