LYDIA SWEETIE broke in the air, recovered to gain the advantage, stayed out from the inside, was put to whip into the far turn and remained clear under urging. PLEASURE TRIP was caught wide while moving to press outside the winner on the first turn, continued to stalk into the far turn then weakened. GIA ALEXA steadied in tight two wide between rivals for much of the first turn, fell back on the backstretch, came out into the three path midway on the final turn and finished willingly. PUPPET ducked out sharply leaving the gate, was caught wide around the first turn, advanced outside on the backstretch while well out from the inside then tired. FLEUR DE FORCE lagged early, was put to whip nearing the far turn, came wide into the stretch and failed to menace. CIRCUS MUSIC was steadied in tight three wide between rivals around the first turn and was finished after five furlongs. CHEVERIE wasn't far back along the rail for over a half then stopped and was eased up in the lane.
