MISS PINK broke in the air while slow from the gate, bumped with PRIMED TO FIRE early on the backstretch, advanced outside, moved two wide to command entering the stretch, was clear soon after, bore out late under steady left hand whip and held. PRIMED TO FIRE bumped with the winner early on the backstretch, wasn't far back in the three path into the stretch then closed a gap from the outside through deep stretch. SULTRY START wasn't far back inside into the turn, fell back, then came out between rivals in the lane and finished willingly. OFFLEE LOVABULL was slow early, raced two wide around the turn and finished with good energy. SAFELY TOUCH opened a clear early lead, angled to the inside then weakened in the drive. FINAL TALE was outrun three wide. TRUST N KEELY was finished early.
