FIELD ADVANTAGE was away in good order to stalk the leaders while racing four-wide, angled out nearing the sixteenth pole and was up in the closing yards. MR. FIXIT broke sharply to press the pace of OLD FAITHFUL while racing three-wide, moved up to take command nearing the five-sixteenths pole, opened a clear margin nearing the quarter, remained in control through mid-stretch, drifted out nearing the sixteenth pole and yielded to the winner late. CALCULATED THINKIN was reserved just off the leaders early, raced three-wide through the turn, angled out with a furlong to run, angled inside nearing the sixteenth pole and finished willingly. FOR THE MOMENT settled off the leaders early, raced five-wide through the turn, checked and angled in nearing the sixteenth pole and finished with good courage. VENOMOUS STATE lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, checked nearing the sixteenth pole, angled out and finished with late interest. OLD FAITHFUL chased the leaders from the inside and weakened through the final furlong. WHITE BLUFF dwelt, raced four-wide through the turn and was not a factor. MAJESTIC CALLING lacked early foot, raced five-wide through the turn and did not menace.
